

FREE INITIAL TELEPHONE ASSESSMENT

After calling to explain your concern and describing events, illness, abnormal behaviour, or any worrying signs affecting your pet, you will be able to discuss and request a home visit.

PET TRANSPORT TO VETERINARY PREMISES *from £50*

I offer transportation from your address to your day veterinary service, as well as transfers from vet hospitals to specialised points of care.

I can support unstable and critical patients from the moment I meet you and your pet, by quickly managing pain and distress and providing first aid vital support like intravenous fluids and oxygen. Your pet will be transported in a vehicle equipped to offer safety and monitoring during the journey.

On-board equipment:

Oxygen cage

Oxygen concentrator

Air-conditioning/Heating system

Fluidio-therapy administration set with pump

Multiparameter monitor

Live video-monitoring

Secure travel-cabin

Disposable bedding

High hygiene and safety measures to prevent cross-contamination

IMPORTANT: many insurance companies do not cover for ambulance transportation of stable/unstable patients. In some cases, insurance companies agree to cover the costs of transportation of critical patients from veterinary premises to specialist points of care, or the costs of any intervention that is considered iderogable for the welfare of the animal as stated by the RCVS Code of Conduct.

Clients are kindly invited to refer to their insurance policy documents to gather this information.

Vetify is unable to access those details and will act truthfully and professionally by sharing the pet's records with the insurer, and I will have no responsibility nor influence on the outcome of their response.

HOME VISIT *from £150*

Vetify aims to offer urgent at-home care to prevent time-consuming and expensive trips to busy veterinary out-of-hours premises.

I support my clients in cases of minor emergencies, providing first-aid treatment to their pet.

After initial assessment in person, where medically acceptable and ethically reasonable, I will give the option to wait for their day-vet opening hours for further investigations and therapy, whilst leaving pet owners assured that their animal condition isn't left without professional assessment.

Vetify intervention (basic/fundamental investigations, first-line administration of medications, initiation of life support):

Minor surgery with local anaesthetic *from* £50 (ex. torn claw, small foreign-body removal, lance abscess...)

Eye test (ex fluorescein, Shirmer tear test... £20)

WRITTEN PRESCRIPTION

When a client runs out of drugs for their pet's on-going treatment, they can call to request a written prescription/the medication.

A prescription will be handed or sent to the client after in-person assessment.

In some instances, the medication is available in stock and can be dispensed right away.

Additional prescription £20

QUIETUS VET (HOME EUTHANASIA)

When the procedure is not considered urgent, I kindly invite pet owners to send me an email requesting a call back.

This will allow me to be available and focused to support and guide my clients in this delicate and emotional process. Whether you came to a final decision, or you need professional advice and reassurance, I will be able to discuss your concerns and available options.

After the last goodbye, clients will be able to share their choice concerning removal of the remains.

Communal cremation and individual cremation will be arranged by Vetify, unless the clients have a different preference on the Company that they would like to use.

Removal of the remains and transportation to a chosen crematorium by Vetify, will be charged depending on travel time from the client address to the company that they chose.

Some companies offer collection from the client's home address and will advise about other services that they provide.

Cremation costs will be available on the crematorium website or can be requested by phoning the company directly.

I will offer small pet keepsakes (ie. paw prints and fur flakes) at no additional cost.
